At the invitation of the Department of Immigration and Border Protection, the Chaldean Australian Society has submitted a written submission on "Australia's Humanitarian Programme 2017-18". This submission includes information about the situation of the Chaldeans in Iraq and neighbouring countries.

Consultation Meeting With Immigration Minister

The Chaldean Australian Society represented by Dr Emad Arabo, a Committee Member, participated in the consultation meeting with the Hon Peter Dutton MP, Minister for Immigration and Border Protection, in Sydney about Australia's Humanitarian Programme 2017-18 and with participation of community organisations and peak bodies. We urged the Australian government to continue providing resettlement for persecuted ethnic and religious Iraqi minorities' refugees and asylum seekers in neighbouring countries (Lebanon, Jordan and Turkey).
